- ★ Bring these Book Tickets with you on the first day of school! Your homeroom teacher will be collecting these as your first official homework assignment.

Throughout the first week of school, Book Tickets will be tallied and displayed throughout the Dupont hallways. The grade level with the most Book Tickets will be awarded the prestigious RAWAC Cup! This trophy will be displayed on the winning grade's floor for all to admire.

To keep the RAWAC Cup on your floor, keep bringing in book tickets every time you finish reading a book (whether it be for homework, a classroom assignment, or your own pleasure). Book tickets will be accepted throughout the entire 2018-2019 school year. Homeroom teachers will have extra Book Tickets, and so will the school website and the main office. Tallies of Book Tickets will be taken monthly, and the RAWAC Cup will move accordingly throughout the grade levels.
