Schedule of Events

Monday Through Friday (every day) Feb 12- Feb 16

Canned Food Drive- Our Biggest and, by far MOST IMPORTANT event of the entire week. Classes compete each day all week to see who will bring in the most food items which are donated annually to Lorraine's Soup Kitchen and Pantry. Different items will be worth double points daily. This is the one main event of the week to truly showcase CHS class and community pride.

Morning Trivia Scramble - Each morning will be highlighted by a live broadcast PRIDE WEEK UPDATE, which will include news, current scoreboard, and three trivia questions worth Pride Week points. Let's welcome Adam Tanguay and Jay Auclair as hosts of this broadcast with the occasional special guest, Jim Blain.

ON-TIME Attendance Contest - Exactly what it sounds like - this one is over at 7:41 every morning. When that bell rings, you're either in or out. (teachers will be strict on this rule during this week)

The Call-Down - Each class will receive daily Pride Week points awarded on the basis of class percentage of the students dressing for each day's theme. Students will be called down to the main lobby at an announced time to be verified and counted. Judges' decision are immediate and final on all qualifiers and exemptions. Students are to walk down the middle staircase, be counted and return immediately to class. Any loitering in the halls or other class disruptions will result in point deductions for the offending class or elimination of this event entirely.

Cafeteria Conclusion- Each day at 12:15, Mrs. Miner and her staff survey and evaluate four entrants per class and award Pride Week points for best dressed for that day's theme. Qualifiers for each day's contest will be chosen and judging passes distributed during the CALL DOWN under the direction of the class advisors.

Pride Week Opening Ceremonies Period 6 (15 minutes into period 6 and 7 - Everyone- Gym)- Students report to 6th period.- Mr. Blain will conduct a varied, fast-moving celebration of CHS Pride, Invited guests, singing, dancing, CHS Band performances, One Minute Pride Speech Competition, and other special student presentations will highlight the afternoon festivities. Also, the revered and legendary “Can’t Find My Homework” Contest. Letters must be right-side up to count, and the word “HOMEWORK” must be spelled correctly.

Pride Week Poster Contest - Vivid displays of student originality and creativity at its best. Location. On the gym wall behind each individual Class Section. Final judging and Pride Week points will be awarded today.

Pride Week Spelling Bee (per 6 -- spelling contestants only - cafeteria) All four classes face off against each other in this Classic Academic Competition. Each class enters a four-student team. Elimination is always a letter away. All four classes leave with points, but only the one student left standing will take away the title.

Wednesday, February 14-

Oratorical Competition and Pride Week Lip-Sync Contest (Period 3-Jr vs. Sr in the auditorium; Per 4 -Fr and Soph in the auditorium) These two events will be combined into one performance period.

Oratorical Competition: Each class will enter two orators with a five minute speaking limit per contestant. Speech themes will be announced in advance. Speeches will be judged both on the basis on content and delivery.

(and during the same assembly period...)

Pride Week Lip-Sinc Contest Hits. Talent. Performance. Entertainment. Each class receives five minutes for their lip-sincing show. All musical selections must have advance approval by the event coordinator. Judging by an appointed committee of faculty and staff using a special version of Olympic event scoring to ensure fairness among all four class performances. All time limits will be strictly enforced!

Crazy Swim Relay (Per 5- Tickets- Platinum Renaissance Cards ONLY)-pool- Team athletic event with a little aquatic twist. Rules and instructions must be carefully followed to avoid disqualification. - a disqualified team receives no Pride Week points!

Miscellaneous Rules - Not to be all encompassing

1. Every student is allowed to do two activities during the week. The one minute pride week speech is an exception and the ultimate events are an exception.
2. On Friday, during the ultimate events, students can do two events but advisors should try and get as many different students involved as possible.
3. Supervisors, APs, and guidance counselors are asked to be a certain points a few minutes before the opening ceremonies and ultimate events to guide students to the appropriate places.

 - Ms. Kruser - In front of gym ushering seniors to their "spot"
 - Ms. Maz- By concession stand
 - Ms. Coletta - By aud and concession stand
4. All coordinators of each event should email BOTH Mr. Tanguay and Mr. Auclair the scores of their specific events. BRIEF highlights can also be emailed to Mr. Tanguay and Mr. Auclair so that they might include them in their Pride Week Updates.
5. Advisors are asked to emphasize that costumes need to show faces and cover bodies appropriately.
6. Cans will be accepted after 7:41 but no points will be given.
7. VERY IMPORTANT- EACH ADVISOR MUST ASSIGN THREE STUDENTS WHO WILL RUN THE LIGHTS AND SOUND DURING TALENT COMPETITION, LIP SINC, AND ORATORICAL. Please give these names to Mrs. Kruser. There will be a tutorial to make sure everyone knows how to use the equipment.
8. Class Officers should see individual coordinators for specific questions on the event. Overall questions, concerns, complaints, and logistical issues should be addressed to Mrs. Kruser.
9. Each class will be assigned one day in the auditorium before the talent competition. An adult needs to be there during this time.

10. (During events) Advisors should stand with their class. Freshmen team teachers should stand with freshmen if possible. Teachers should spread out among all exits.
