### **ADVANCED COLLEGE/UNIVERSITY PROGRAM COURSES**

All college level courses taken during school hours must be approved by the superintendent and be part of an advanced college/university program. Courses taken at night are at the option of the student. In no instance will such courses be used toward graduation requirements or to compute class rank unless approved by the Department Supervisor, Principal and Superintendent or his/her designee. The School Committee places no limit on the number of courses which a student may take and the student may seek financial aid available through normal channels at the college.

A qualified student enrolled in a public school may be enrolled as a student in a Massachusetts institution of higher education. The student shall earn both secondary school and college credits. Students may enroll either full time or for individual courses. The secretary in consultation with the council and the Board of Education shall define which students qualify for this program, establish criteria for admissions, and otherwise administer this program.
