Please Pick Up Your Medications

If your child has medication in the clinic, it must be picked up by an ADULT prior to the last day of classes. All medication, prescription or over the counter, left in the clinic after 11:30 A.M. on June 22, 2018 will be destroyed. Due to medication policies and to ensure the safety of our children, NO medication will be sent home with any child. Medication orders and parental consent for next year will be sent home soon to be completed over the summer.

5th Grade Health Lesson: Attention 5th grade parents, the district health lesson for fifth graders will be held the week of June 1, 2018. A formal notice has already been sent home. If you do not wish for your child to participate, please send in a written notice stating so.



Warm Weather has finally arrived. Please make sure your child is dressed accordingly. Our school does not have air conditioning and it can get quite warm during the afternoon hours. Send your child to school with a water bottle during warm days to stay hydrated.



Field trips are in full swing as well as allergies and illness.
